Did you type in your name and period on the page?	Both = 5, one = 3, Handwritten or No = 2	/5
Does the drawing have a key for symbols you are using in your drawing?	Yes = 5, No = 2	/5
Do you indicate the scale of the drawing, e.g. 1/4 inch = 1 foot? Did you show the overall dimensions of the project?	Both = 5, one = 4, No = 2	/5
Is the drawing entirely in black and white?	Yes = 5, No = 2	/5
Are all of the rooms and important furniture or cabinet pieces labeled?	Rate from 5-10	/10
Are the walls eight inches thick and shown to scale on your drawing?	Completely = 5 Incompletes 3-4 No = 2	/5
Do you show your doors and how they swing (with an arc)? If the doors slide, like patio doors do, did you show that?	Completely = 5 Incompletes 3-4 No = 2	/5
Does your project meet basic electrical codes, at least one outlet per wall and separate outlets for any major appliances?	Completely = 5 Incompletes 3-4 No = 2	/5
